

## Instructions

## Installs in seconds with no tools required!

## Installation

- Twist the cooler off the mounting bracket.
- Remove the wingnut from the bolt and remove the bolt from the bracket.
- Add or remove rubber gaskets as required to fit your shaft.
- Locate the Cool Caddy on your pull cart shaft near the golf bag but not close enough to obstruct the cooler from swivelling.
- Feed the bolt through the square hole in the bracket, through the gaskets holes and out the round hole.
- Put the wing nut on the threaded bolt end and twist until snug.
- Attach the cooler and check the range of motion.
- Re-locate bracket as required and tighten bolt.

## Usage

- Remove hot cup for 12 oz. cans.
- Twist cans to remove from cooler.
- Remove cans immediately after use.
- Tighten wingnut as necessary.
- Keep the Velcro surfaces free of debris.
- Store cooler in golf bag when not in use.





The cooler MUST be PUSHED ON and DOWN FIRMLY to attach it correctly to the mounting plate. If you do not attach the cooler properly it may fall off during use. Remove cans by TWISTING them out NOT PULLING. The coolers are made of soft foam and will rip if pulled hard enough. US Patent No. 5,494,284
